




- Funding up to \$150,000 per project
- 1:1 Match.
- 12 18 months to complete the project
- Eligible Applicants: Nonprofits, Education, Govt., IDA, EDA
- Can be new or expanding program/project, construction or non-construction
- CANNOT be continuation of existing program or project (also known as Maintenance of Effort).






