2023 REGIONAL PLANNING & TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- Provided project development and technical assistance to 68 unique local organizations for Area Development & IIJA opportunities. Hosted 4 grant writing sessions, with 36 attendees, reviewed 15 pre-applications & assisted in preparing 9 FY2024 Area Development applications, totaling \$1,275,614.
- Hosted 4 CEDS "Sync-Up Sessions" to provide partner networking opportunities and project development, with 97 attendees.
- Provided grant administration assistance (including ArcNet training) for 45 Active Projects: 38 Area Development, 3 POWER, 4 INSPIRE.
- Hosted Regional Broadband Collaborative, leading the FCC Map Challenge and 2nd Annual Upstate Rural Broadband Conference, approx. **136** attendees.
- Successfully completed ARC's 1st INSPIRE Recovery-to-Work Ecosystem Development Program.
- Drafted a new regional 5-year plan (Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy, CEDS 2023-2027).
- Advocated for the New Energy New York Tech Hub designation for Battery Innovation across Appalachia New York.
